

# Healing of Youth

#### "I am the Child that the Village Helped Raise" –Victor Rivas Rivers



A veteran star of more than two dozen films, Victor Rivas Rivers may be best known for such roles as Magic Mike, Murphy's sidekick in The Distinguished Gentleman, and Antonio Banderas' ill-fated brother in The Mask of Zorro. On television Victor has guest starred on such hit shows as Better Call Saul, Modern Family, C.S.I. Miami, 24, Miami Vice, Jag, and Star Trek.

Born in Cuba, Victor came with his family to the U.S. at the age of two, enduring horrific child abuse and witnessing abuse on the level of torture at the hands of his father. At age fifteen, Victor took the then unprecedented legal action against his father, going on to live with a series of foster families. Thanks to the intervention of his community, he turned his life around dramatically – going from gangmember to senior class President and lettering in four sports. He attended Florida State University on a full four-year football scholarship. A team captain and scholar athlete, upon graduation he was drafted by the Miami Dolphins with whom he was out as an offensive lineman for their 1978/79 seasons.

In 1999, with a successful career and family of his own, Victor decided to break his silence about his childhood. His ultimate survival and personal success convey the importance of intervention by others who helped him break the cycle of violence.

Youth Haven is Collier County's only emergency and residential shelter for children and teens ages 6–21 who have experienced abuse, neglect, or homelessness. Located on an 18.5-acre therapeutic campus in Naples, Florida, Youth Haven provides trauma-informed care including therapy, education, life skills, and enrichment. Accredited and licensed, Youth Haven is committed to its mission of providing Home, Hope, and Healing to abused and neglected youth in Southwest Florida, and to its vision of a bright future for every child and teen in congregate care.

#### BY THE **NUMBERS**

since 1972

Youth Haven first opened its doors to children in 1972, and has since provided continuous care on a 18.5-acre therapeutic campus in Naples, Florida.

24/7

Children & teens, ages 6 - 21, who are abused, neglected, or homeless come to Youth Haven and receive 24-hour care. They are severely traumatized and in crisis.

270 days

The average stay is 270 days before being placed in a home; however, children can remain at Youth Haven for much longer depending upon their situation.

**74** beds

Currently, up to 74 youth can reside on campus, encompassing approximately 27,000 bed nights

2014

Youth Haven developed the Homeless Teen and Transitional Living Program (HTTLP) in 2014, dedicated to serving homeless teens age 16 - 21.

2023

Completion of an intake cottage providing a space for children with communicable diseases to isolate, ensuring health and safety for the entire campus.
